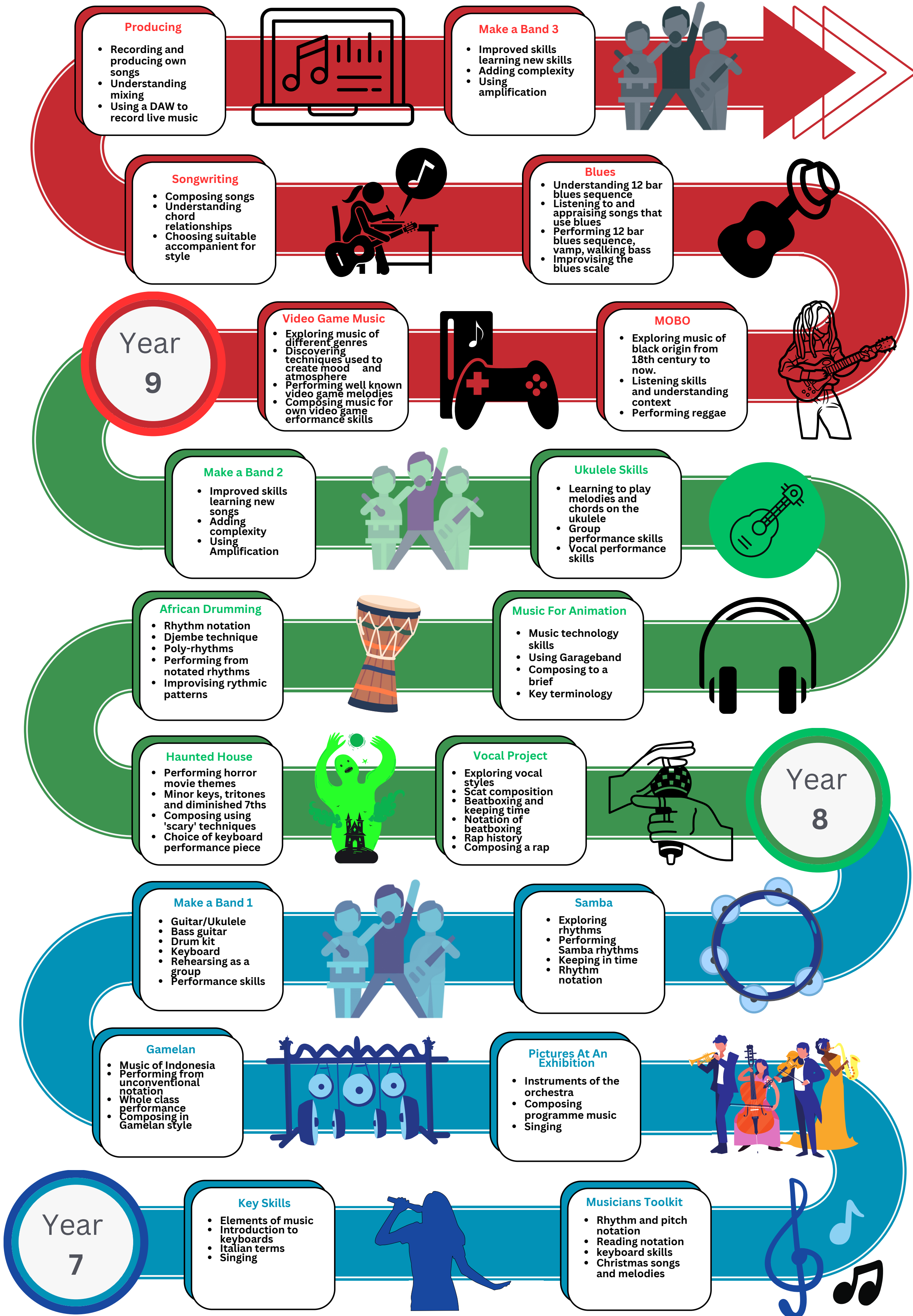


Music Key Stage 3 Learning Journey
