- ◆ To complete assignments, coursework and/or homework on time and to be proud of what I am submitting.
- ◆ To devote at least fifteen hours per week to independent research/study in addition to timetabled lessons if on an Advanced level course.
- ◆ To use study periods effectively for the completion of work or to participate in community service activities.
- ◆ To use the Library and Sixth Form areas sensibly and with consideration for others.
- ◆ To perform all duties conscientiously and competently.
- ◆ To behave in an appropriate manner as a senior member of the school.
- ◆ To dress appropriately as a senior member of the school (see the Sixth Form dress code).
- ◆ To remain in school for all study periods until study leave or home study has been granted by the Head of Sixth Form.
- ◆ To attend all educational activities provided by the school, regardless of home study. This includes tutor periods.
