Why vaccinate?

- As part of their childhood immunisation programme
- Protection against Human Papiolum virus (HPV)
- If vaccinated between 12 and 13 years of age 87% protection against HPV related cancers and 97% against pre-cancerous cells. .
- Catch up of MMR-measles, mumps and rubella if still outstanding (2 combined doses required after 12 months of age)
- Vaccinate to protect them against this virus!
