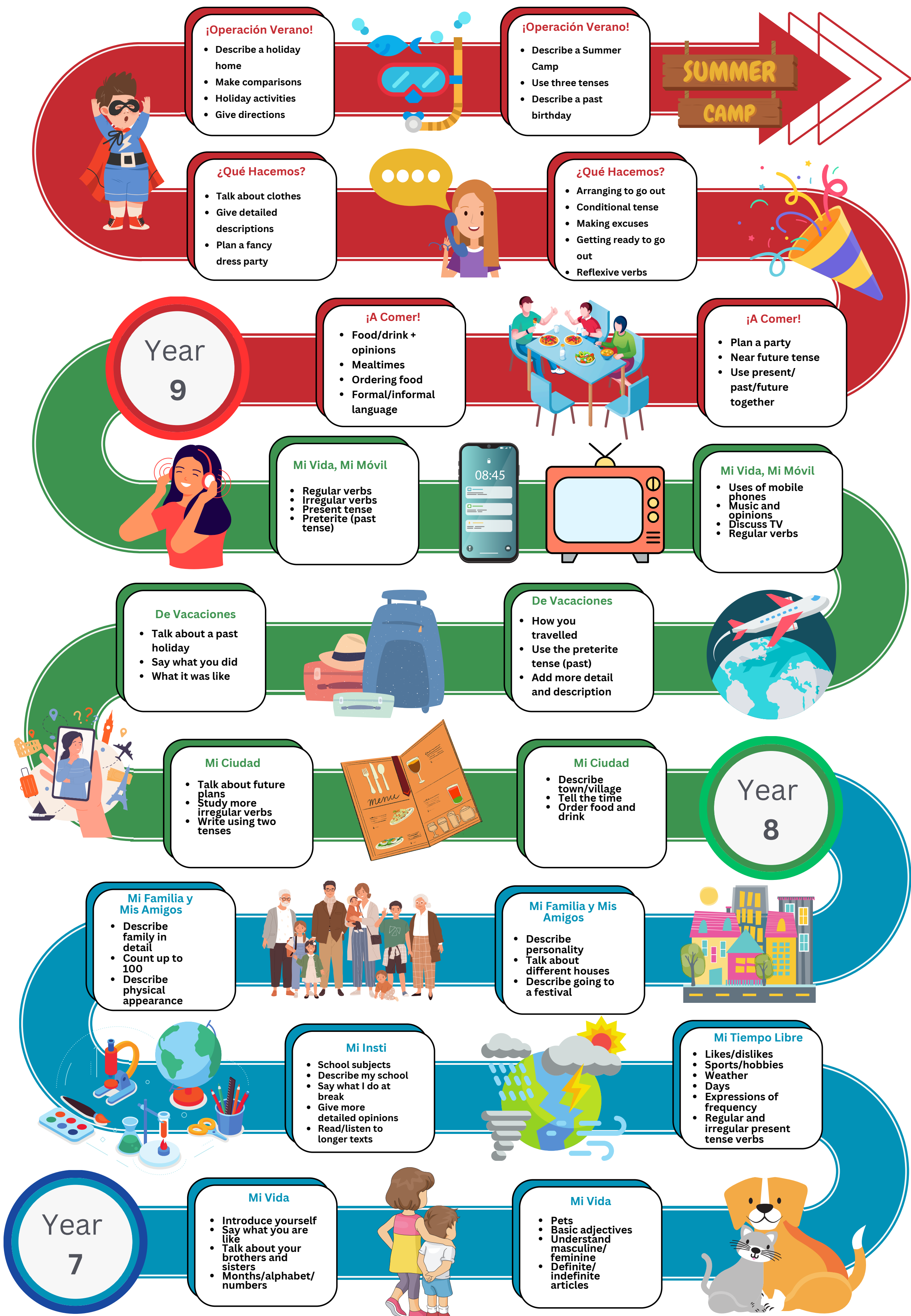


Spanish Key Stage 3 Learning Journey



Year 9 Overview

By the end of Year 9 students will be able to use 3 tenses more confidently. Topics covered include holidays, talking about music and technology preferences, planning a party or a special event, including clothes and daily routine. All topics will include more stretching grammar work and students will be challenged to learn reflexive verbs and the future conditional tense which will prepare them for GCSE.

Year 8 Overview

Students will continue to build on the grammar they have studied in Year 7 and consolidate the present tense but now starting to use more irregular verbs. By the end of Year 8 they will be able to use the near future tense and talk about what they are going to do and the preterite tense to talk about the past. They will learn how to talk more about their family and where they live, say how they use social media and give their opinions. They will be able to give opinions about food and talk about celebrations and describe a past holiday.

Year 7 Overview

Students will be able to introduce themselves giving details about themselves and others. They will also be able to start to talk about their likes and dislikes and give more details about their family and pets and learn a variety of different adjectives and present tense verb forms. They will be able to talk about their school subjects and give basic details about school life. They will start to be able to talk about where they live and build on their grammar knowledge.
