

Urdu Key Stage 3 Learning Journey



Year 9 Overview

By the end of Year 9 students will be able to use 3 tenses more confidently. Topics covered include personal identification, hobbies & interests, talk about their home and area as well as describing their daily routine. All topics will include more stretching grammar work and pupils will be challenged to read full paragraph which include past, present and future tenses, translate paragraphs into target language to prepare them for GCSE reading tasks.

Year 8 Overview

Students will continue to build on the grammar they have studied in Year 7 and consolidate the present tense but now starting to expand their sentences, use negative sentences and start to manipulate some verbs in past tense and develop further joined handwriting. By the end of Year 8 they will be able to use present tense, past tense, and some near future forms. They will learn how to talk more about their family and where they live, customs & festivals of Pakistan, name animals, birds and food and count from one till fifty. They will be able to give opinions about food and describe the weather and name the seasons.

Year 7 Overview

Students will be able to introduce themselves giving details about themselves. They will also be able to start to talk about their likes and dislikes and give more details about their family and learn present tense verb forms. They will be able to start to talk briefly about their school and name the school subjects. They will start to be able to talk about where they live, name fruits and vegetables, animals and items of clothing. They will be able to use Urdu alphabet to spell words within a family of letters and do joined handwriting.
