SPORTS DAY – FRIDAY 20 JUNE

This year, we will again be holding our annual Sports Day at the Stoke Mandeville Stadium on **Friday 20 June 2025**.

This venue will give our athletes the advantage of being able to use high quality specialist facilities, encouraging more students to participate actively to a high standard. The venue is also large enough to allow for a whole-school event, encouraging 'Sport for All' with all students and staff being there to support the athletes.

For those who like a less competitive experience of a real athletics track, students can make a donation to our chosen charity (more information to follow) and enter the 'fun run' where they can walk/run alongside friends and staff around the track during the lunch break.

All students should report directly to the Stadium promptly at 8.30am for registration.

All students, both competitors and spectators, should arrive at the Stadium in the correct Grange School PE kit. Please ensure your child comes prepared for all weather conditions (sun cream/waterproofs) and brings plenty of water to drink. Refreshment facilities at the Stadium will not be available, so they should bring a packed lunch. If your child receives a free school meal, a packed lunch will be provided. The PTA will be selling drinks and sweets.

The event will end at 3.00 pm.

Support for Students Getting to the Stadium

If there are individual circumstances which mean your child will need to be escorted to/from school by staff, at either the start or end of the event, and/or if weather causes the event to be abandoned earlier, and your child will need to be accompanied back to school, then you need to complete this online form: [Request for Child to be Escorted](#), signing in with your child's school email address, **by 400pm on Tuesday 17 June 2025**.

If your child is going to be escorted to school, please ensure that they are in the school canteen by 8.15 am.

You do **not** need to complete this form if your child can travel to/from the stadium unescorted by staff.

Visitors

We welcome visitors to our Sports Day; the programme will be published on Satchel where you will be able to see approximate times for when your child will be competing. If parents/carers wish to attend, they will need to request a visitor's pass via this online form [Visitor Pass Request](#), signing in with their child's school email address, **by 4.00pm on Tuesday 17 June 2025**.

Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate friends/family who are 18 years old or younger.


In the event of Sports Day being cancelled on the day due to poor weather, a message will be posted on Satchel and the school Facebook/Instagram accounts from **7.00 am**, informing you that school will take place as normal, and students will need the necessary equipment for those lessons. If it is 'abandoned' during the day due to inclement weather, we will let you know via Satchel and the school Facebook/Instagram accounts, and we will send students home.

Many of our students will be competing, but for those who are spectating, there is an expectation that this will occur in a sporting and dignified manner. I would like to remind all students that we fully expect appropriate behaviour at all times when travelling to and from the stadium, without causing disruption or inconvenience to others.
