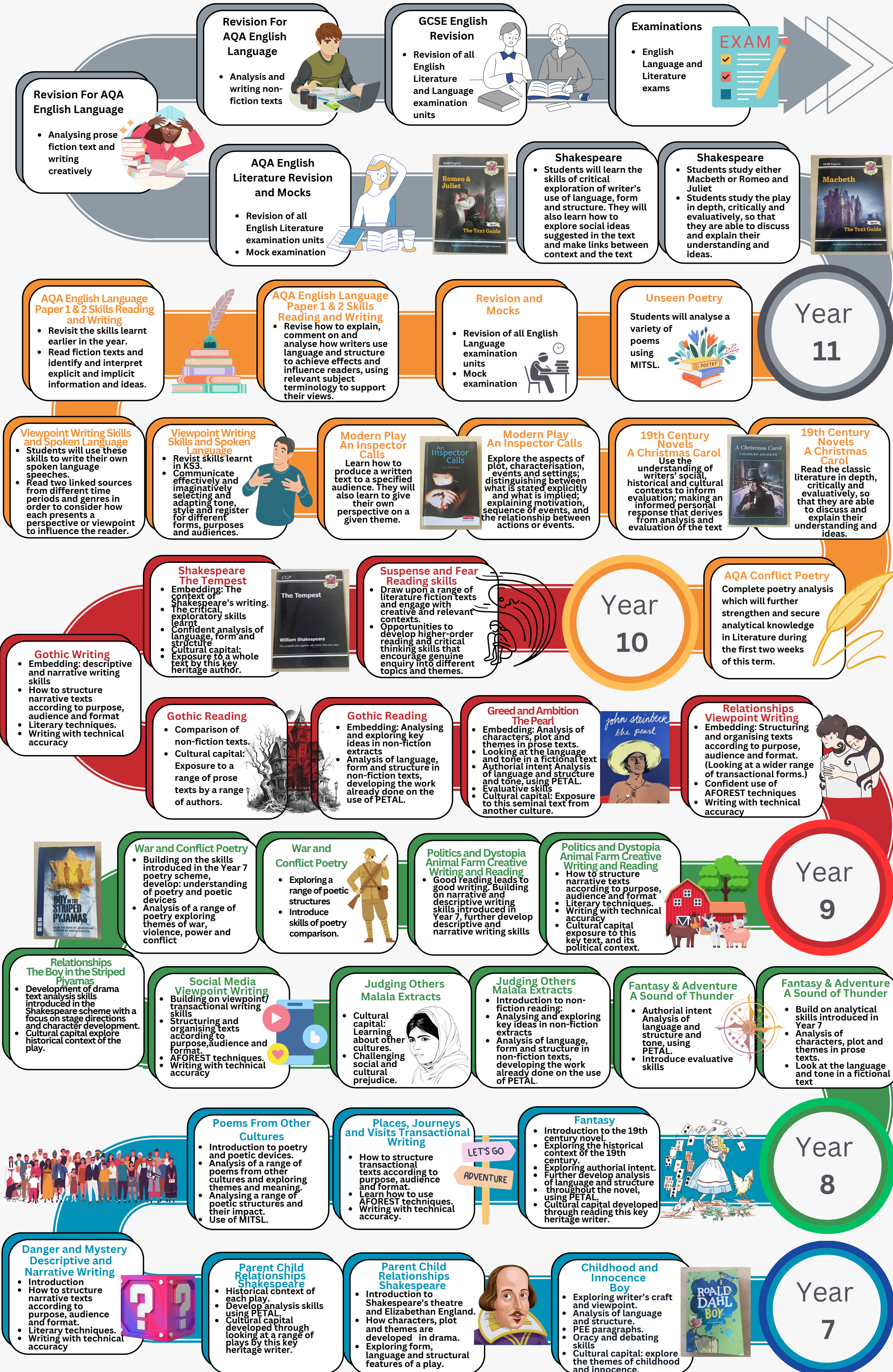


English Key Stage 3 and 4 Learning Journey



Year 11 Overview
