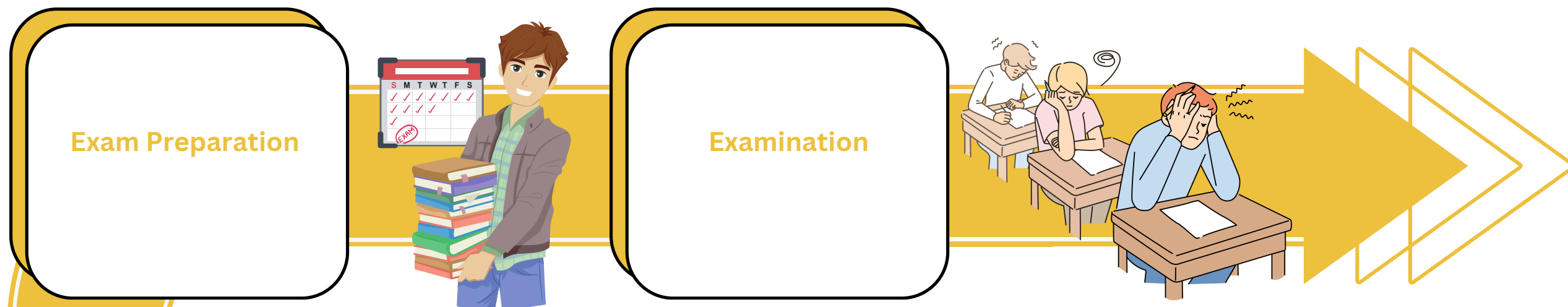
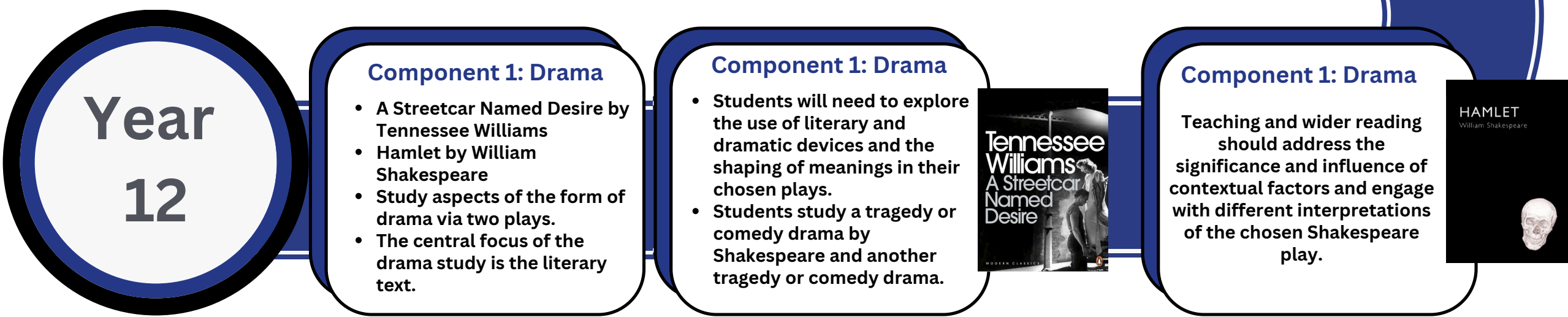
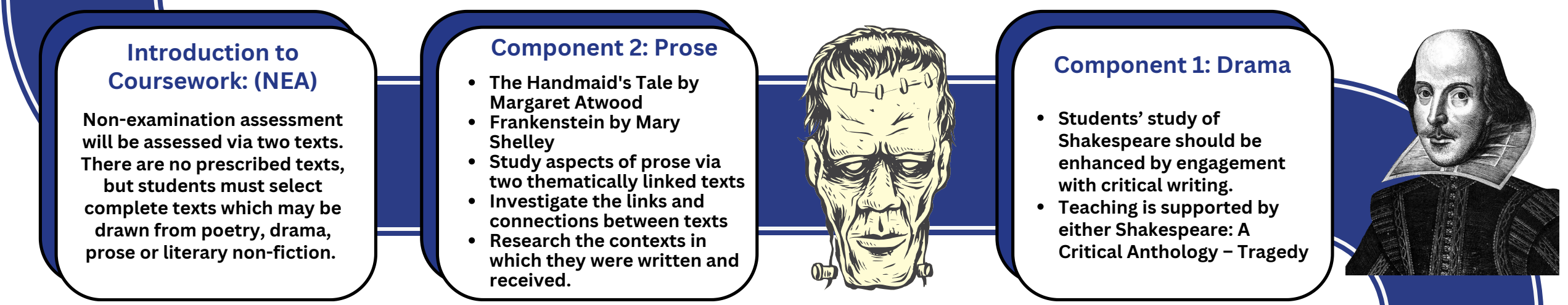
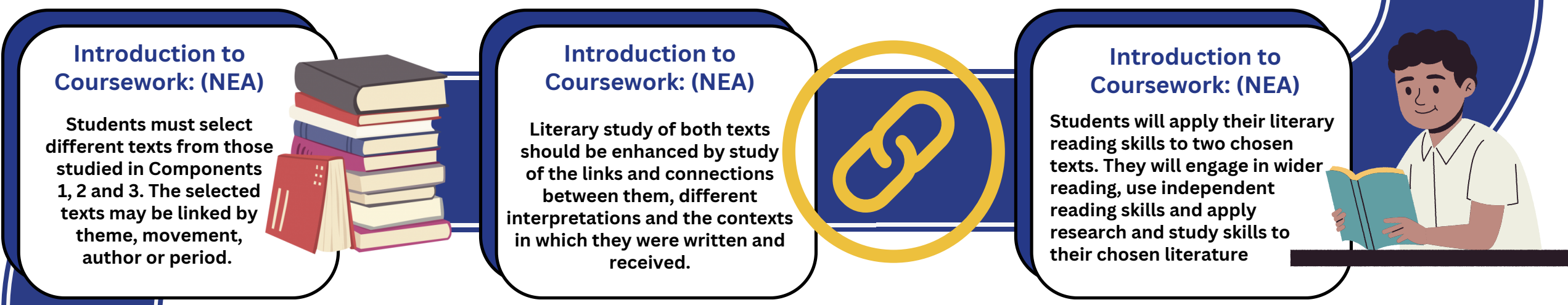
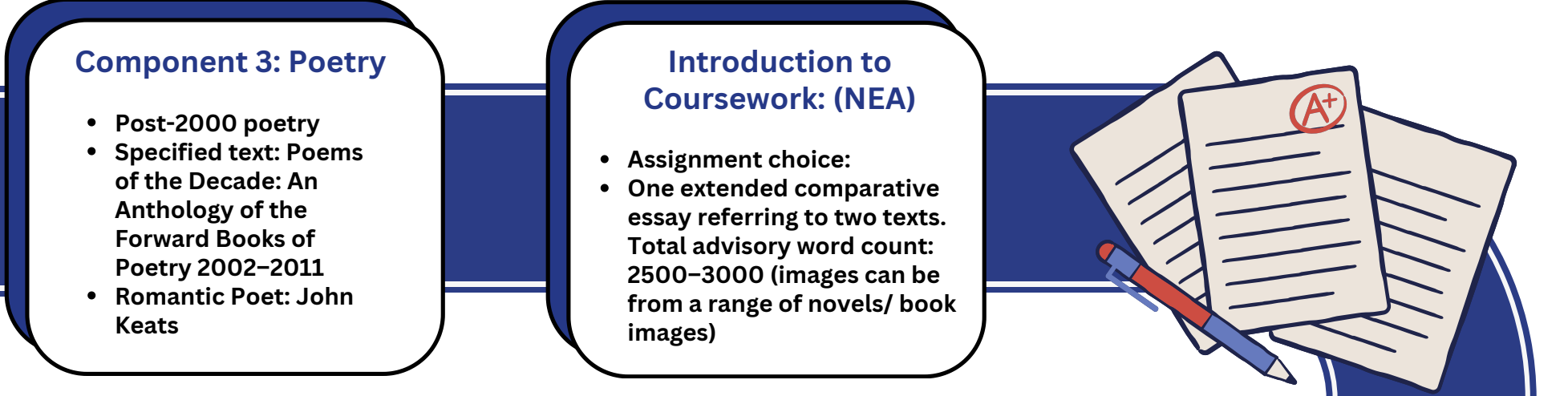
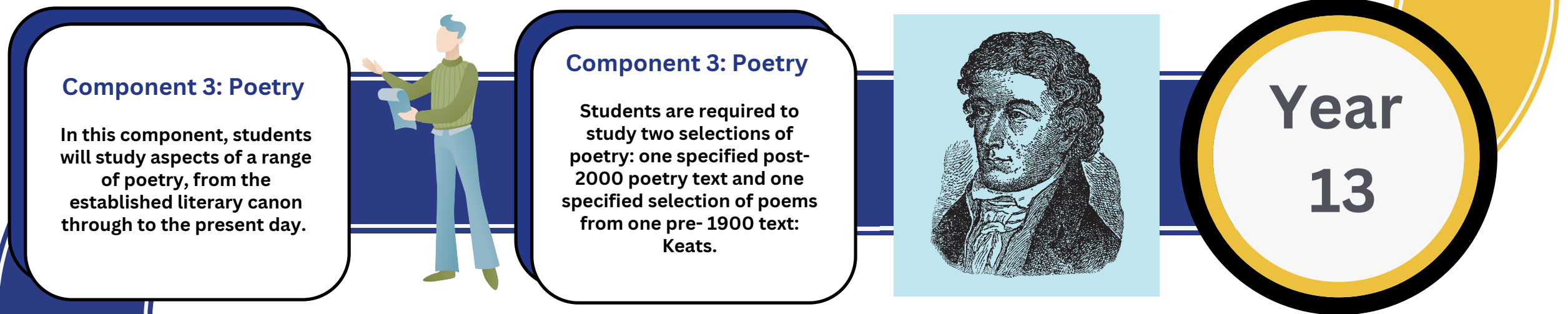
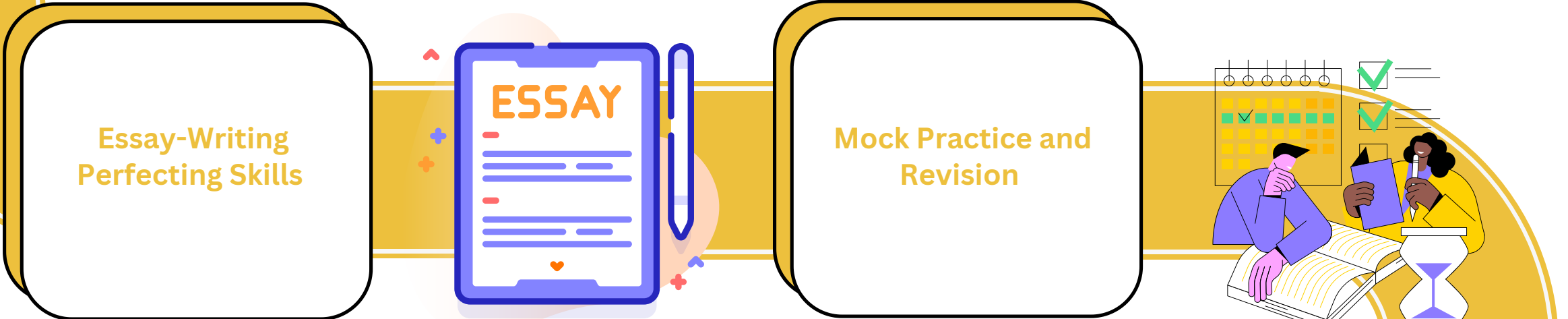


English Literature Key Stage 5 Learning Journey
