## IN FOCUS - AN UPDATE FROM THE SAFEGUARDING TEAM

From this academic year onwards, all students will need to be dropped and collected at one of the two gates either side of the school. Students will no longer be able to use reception at the start and the end of the day. This request has been in place for a number of years - however over the last few months there has been an increase in the traffic through reception at the start and end of the day which has raised some concerns.

There are a number of reasons for this but primarily for safeguarding and safety of all students and staff as well as visitors. If your child is met by an LSA or another member of staff, this will take place at Stapleton House gate going forward and individual discussions will take place with you directly about that.

We ask that no parents or carers sit in reception unless you are having a pre-arranged meeting with a member of staff or are directed to by our reception team.

I am sure that you will be able to support us with this move in ensuring that our safeguarding of the children and staff remain at its highest levels. Please be aware we will politely ask you to move if you are in reception.

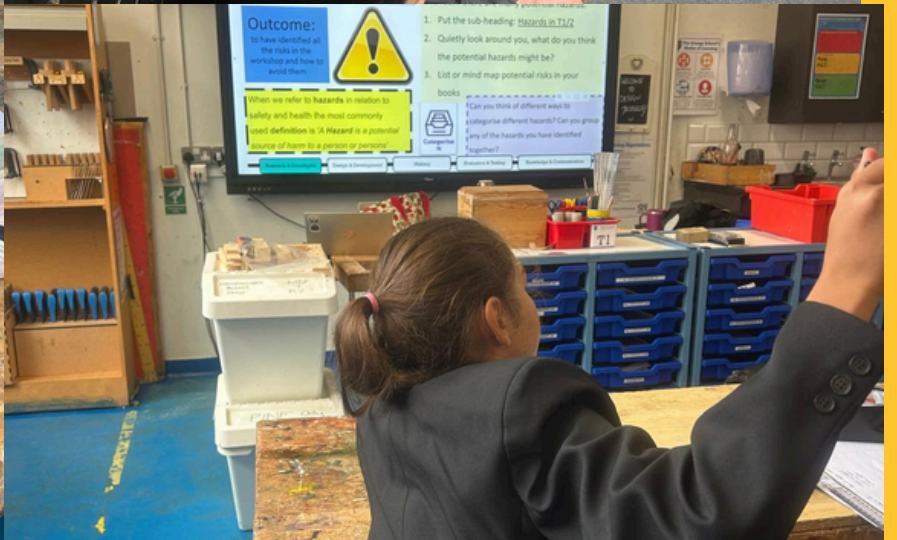

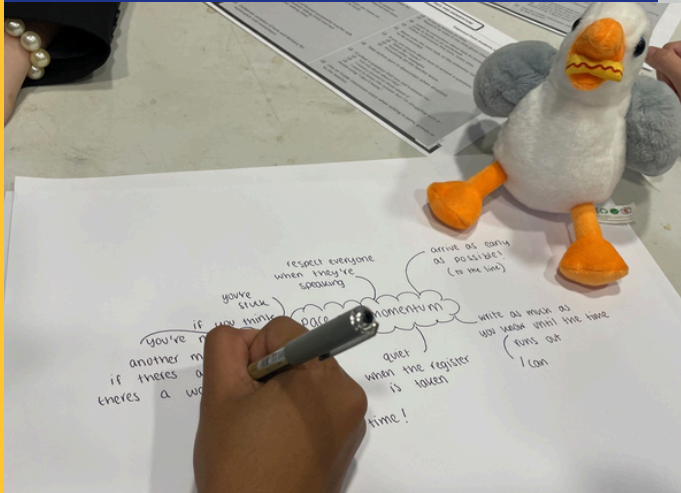
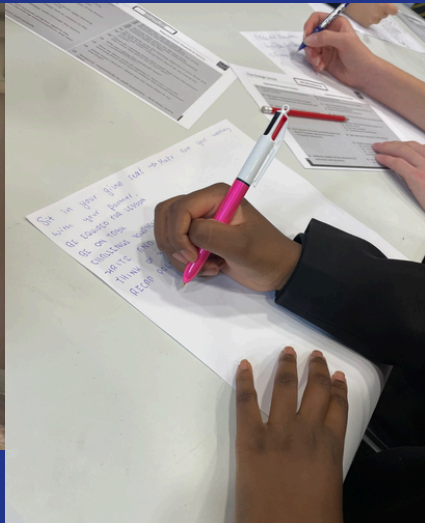
