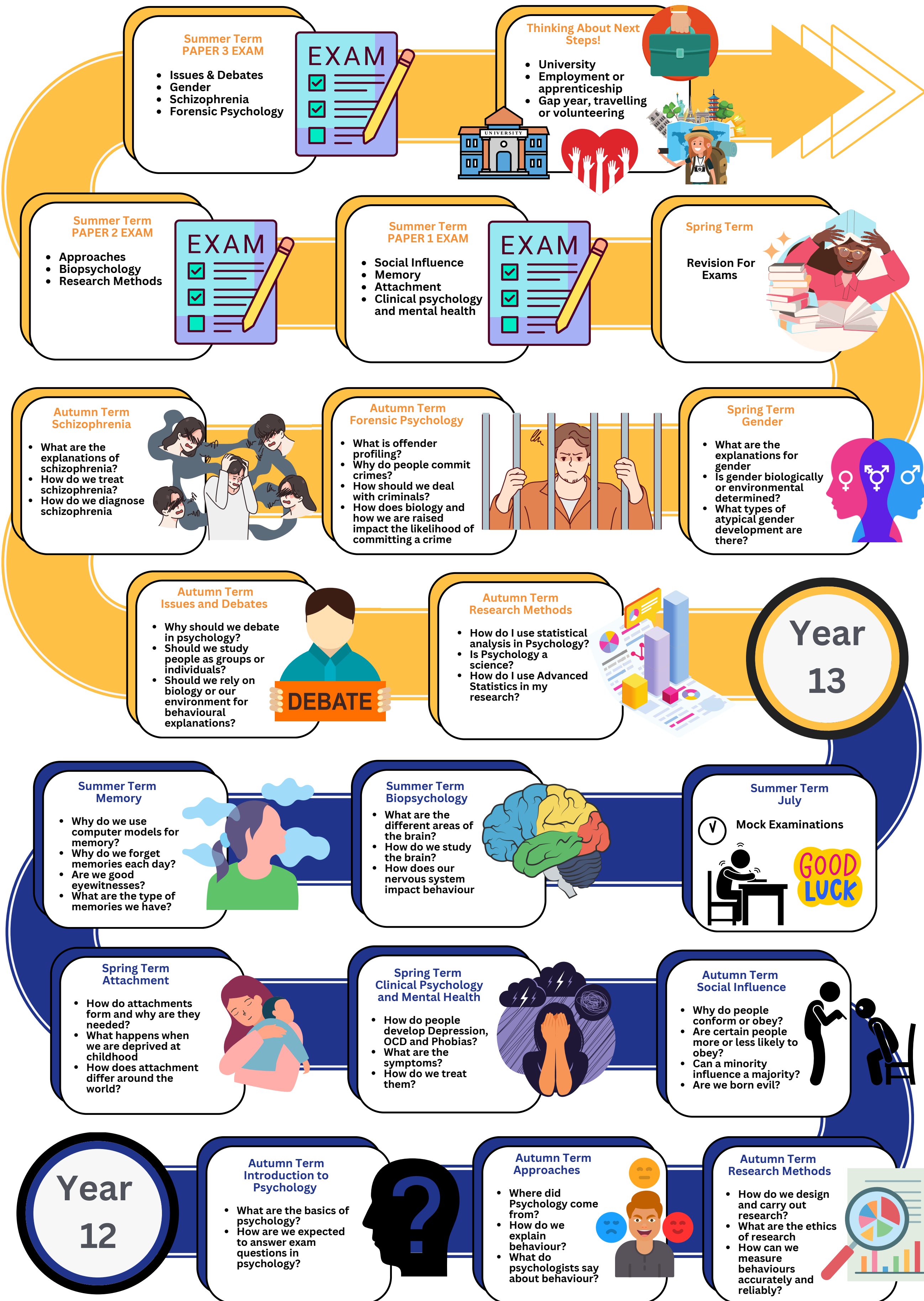


Psychology A Level Learning Journey



Year 13 Overview

Students will build upon their knowledge from Year 12 and apply this to further applied topics in Psychology. The basis of Y13 is to look holistically at examples and theories within psychology and be able to evaluate and analyse effectively to a range of examples, case studies and research methods skills. Students will continue to be assessed through end of topic assessments and mock exams in order to further develop exam skills ready for the external examinations at the end of the year.
