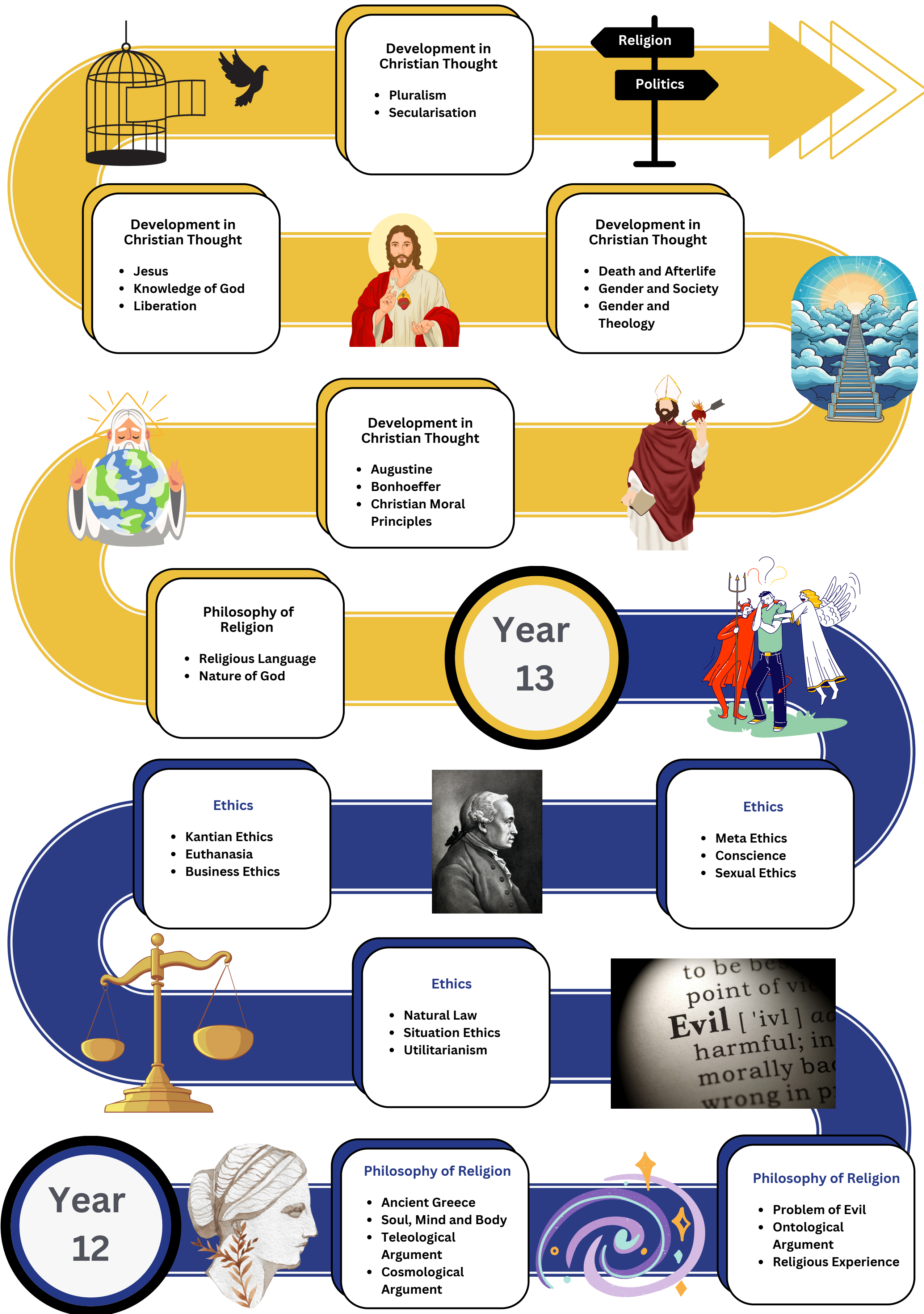


Religious Studies A Level Key Stage 5 Learning Journey
