Re: Easter Revision Sessions

I am pleased to let you know that we will be holding a wide range of revision lessons over the Easter break. We have been offering these for a number of years, and they have proved to be very popular as well as very useful.

Final exams will start soon after Easter, so the break should be seen as an excellent opportunity to study and prepare for them. It can be a challenging time for students and the more preparation they can put in, the better able they will be to cope with the added pressures.

I have attached the current Timetable of sessions for both Year 11 and Year 12/13 to this letter, but it will also be found on our website. I would recommend that students continue to check for any communications from the school during the holiday, as if staff are ill or something happens then the sessions would not be covered.

Students are not required to wear school uniform for the Easter lessons but will need to dress appropriately for a school environment. There will be no food facilities, so they should bring some water and also some food if they feel it is needed. They will be given a break during the lesson.

These sessions are focused and demanding, so students should come prepared to work hard. Any poor behaviour or distracting of others, will result in students being asked to leave.

Students will be required to enter and exit via the Stapleton House gate and also, as there will be maintenance work taking place on the site, they need to stay in the area around the classroom and not wander the school site.
