IN FOCUS - PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTIONS

We are inviting nominations for a new Parent Governor to join the Governing Board. No formal qualifications are needed, just enthusiasm, common sense, and a commitment to supporting the school community. Governors attend around four early-evening meetings each term and are encouraged to visit the school during the year. Full training and support are provided, and the term of office lasts three years.

We welcome nominations from parents and carers from all backgrounds. Candidates must be proposed and seconded by fellow parents or carers with children currently at the school. Please note that school employees working more than 500 hours a year and elected members of the Local Authority are not eligible.

If more than one nomination is received, a secret postal ballot will take place, with one vote per parent/carer per vacancy. Should the position remain unfilled, the Governing Board may appoint a suitable parent or carer to ensure full representation.

The survey is completely anonymous, unless you choose to include your child's name at the end.

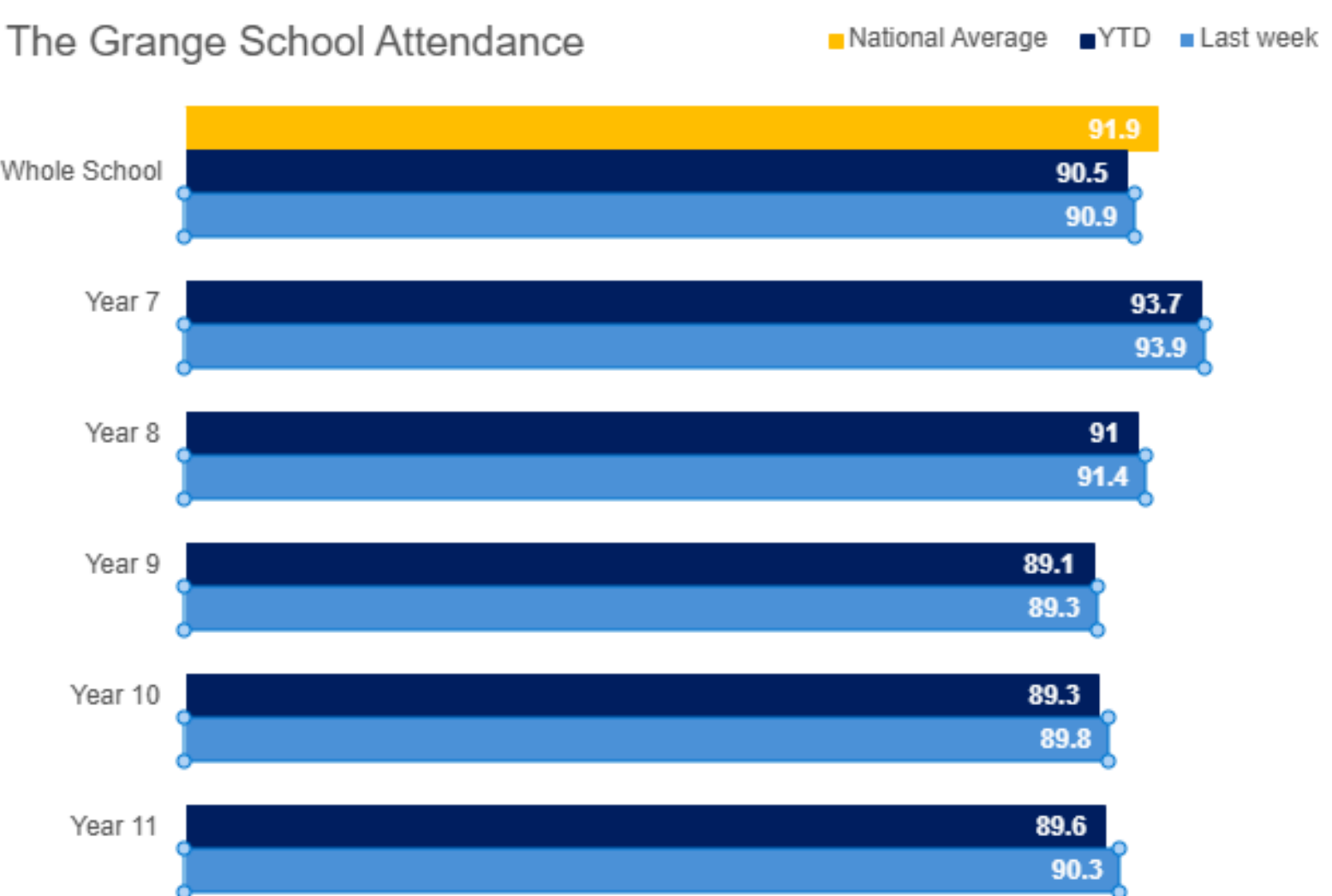

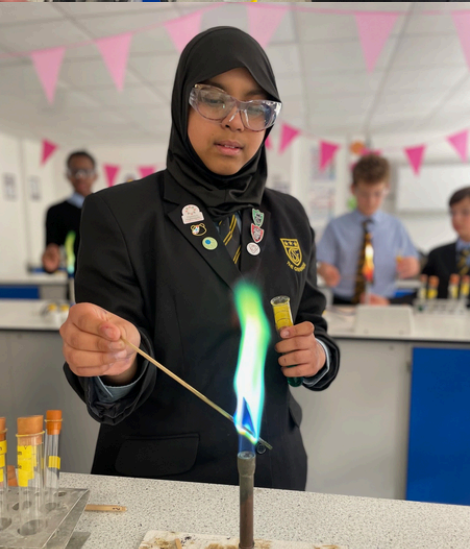
THE GRANGE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

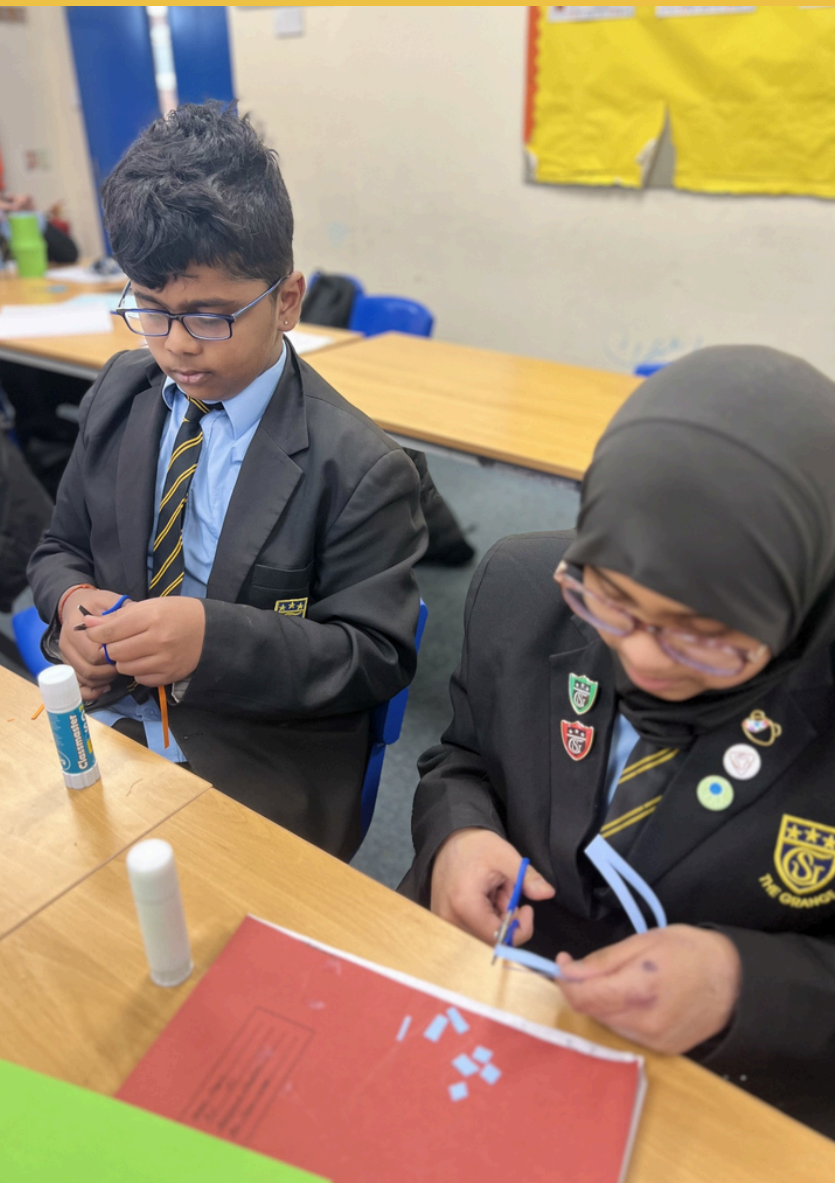
