Re: Year 11 Key Stage 4 Results Day

This letter is to confirm arrangements for the Year 11 KS4 Results Day on **Thursday 20 August 2026.**

Results Day: The Grange School staff will be in school on results day for students to collect their results.

Time: 9.30am - 11.30am in the main hall

On Thursday 20 August 2026, the results will also be available electronically on your child's student Bromcom portal by 10am. Please ensure that student's check they are able to access their Bromcom portal and also their Grange school email address. Any issues with accessing their Bromcom portal and email please contact our IT support email as soon as possible on parent-IT-help@grange.bucks.sch.uk. Students can download a pdf copy of their results from Bromcom and we strongly suggest students do this to retain an electronic copy of their results. A reminder too for students to sign up for the Education Record app too.

If students cannot collect their own results, they may authorise someone else to collect on their behalf. The students will need to email the Exams Officer, Mrs Cox on exams@grange.bucks.sch.uk and give the details of the person who you authorise to collect results on your behalf, the person attending will then need to have photo ID with them.

Grange School 6th form

Sixth Form enrolment will take place in school on **Thursday 20th August and Friday 21 August 2026**. Staff will be available to discuss results and applications on **Thursday from 10.00am until 1.00pm** in the **6th form study centre**. We will check student's grades to ensure that we can offer a place in our 6th Form and also check chosen subjects. Staff will also be in school for enrolment on **Friday 21 August between 10.00am and 12 noon**. Mr Sabin will be available via his email dsabin@grange.bucks.sch.uk for any questions.
