This letter is to confirm arrangements for the Y13 KS5 Results Day on **Thursday 13 August 2026.**

Results Day: The examination staff will be in school on results day for students to collect their results.

Time: 9.30am - 10.30 am in courtyard outside main reception

On Thursday 13 August 2026, the results will also be available electronically on your child's student Bromcom portal by 12.00pm. Please ensure that student's check they are able to access their Bromcom portal and also their Grange school email address. Any issues with accessing their Bromcom portal and email, please contact our IT support email as soon as possible on parent-IT-help@grange.bucks.sch.uk. Students can download a pdf copy of their results from Bromcom and we strongly suggest students do this to retain an electronic copy of their results.

If students cannot collect their own results, they may authorise someone else to collect on their behalf. The students will need to email the Exams Officer, Mrs Cox on exams@grange.bucks.sch.uk and give the details of the person who they authorise to collect results on their behalf, the person attending will then need to have photo ID with them.

What if students are not sure what they are doing next or want help with next steps?

Mr Sabin, Mrs Devaney and Mrs Kittles will be in school between 9.30am and 11.00am on Thursday 13 August 2026 if students need to discuss their results or next steps. They can also support students with any UCAS queries they may have. They will be contactable on their school email if students cannot attend the school in person.
