## **Re: Year 12 Mock Examinations June 2026**

This is to inform you of the arrangements for our next GCE mock examinations for all students in Year 12. These examinations begin on **Monday 29 June** and last through until **Friday 3 July 2026** inclusive.

Please find attached a timetable for these assessments, including rooming's. Timetables can also be accessed via the Bromcom - My Child at School App Bromcom; they should be showing over the course of the next week.

Students have been informed of the arrangements for the examinations in assembly and via their form tutors, but for your information:

- a) Students must report 10 minutes before the official starting time of the examinations. So, this should be **8.50 am** for the morning examinations and **1.20 pm** for the afternoon examinations.
- b) Students should **study at home** when **not** in exams and register in the examination room. However, please note that some BTEC lessons might still go ahead depending on the subject. BTEC students need to confirm this with their class teacher.
- c) Full details of venues will be displayed in the main school foyer daily. These details often involve the use of candidate numbers, all students must know their candidate number.
- d) Smart business attire must be worn for all examinations. Failure to comply with this instruction could mean that students will be sent home to change.
- e) School bags and mobile phones are not to be taken into any examination room. They will be securely stored in specific allocated rooms. If a mobile phone rings, vibrates or receives a text message during an examination, the invigilator will report it to the Examinations Office, and the candidate's paper will be declared void.
- f) All students must ensure that they bring the necessary equipment for the relevant examination, including two black pens. Equipment is not provided by the school and may not be borrowed from another candidate.
- g) If your child is ill, please telephone the school and inform Mrs Cox of the illness by **8.30 am**.

Normal timetable will resume for all Year 12 students at the end of the Mock examinations.
