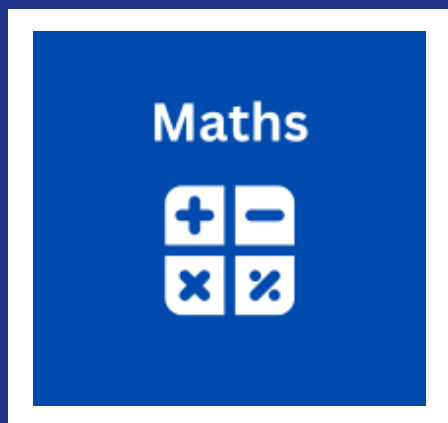

Day Trips

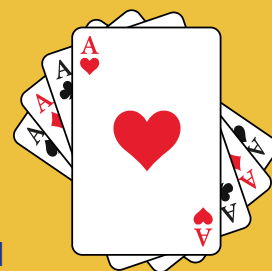
