Uniform Expectations – Your support is appreciated

Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you are looking forward to a relaxing summer and hope the excellent weather lasts.

I am writing to ask for your ongoing support in upholding the standards of uniform we will need to reestablish in September following such a long hot spell and with students in PE kit. With the summer break followed by a new academic year in September, this is the time we look to ensure all of our students look their best and wear their uniform with pride.

The vast majority of our students look amazing in immaculate uniform and I thank you for this. Sadly, a small number of students choose to arrive in school without full Grange School Uniform and without explanation. Our uniform expectations are clear and have not changed. [Please see the school website for full details of our uniform](#), to ensure you do not purchase any unsuitable (and expensive) items that you would need to replace.

For clarity, the most common misconceptions are:

- **Nose Studs** – If you wish your child to have a nose stud, please ensure it is pierced early enough in the holiday to heal before they return in September. They will be expected to remove it.
- **Trainers** - We expect black unbranded school shoes. Not Nike Airforce or any other branded trainer.
- **V Neck Jumper** - Students are permitted to wear a plain black v neck jumper UNDER their blazer if they choose. The jumper is optional and never an alternative to the blazer which must be worn every day.

It is clear in our uniform policy that if students are not in correct uniform, families will be contacted and students either sent home to change, or families asked to bring the correct uniform into school. Thankfully, this is rare, but we rely on your support if we need to do this.

Can I please ask for your support in discussing this with your child and to ensure they are fully equipped for when they return in September. If there is difficulty in ensuring full uniform is available, please contact your child's form tutor with a note or email on the day your child comes to school.
