The Grange Sixth Form Mobile Phone Policy

At The Grange Sixth Form, we recognise that mobile phones are an important tool for learning and professional development.

Students are expected to use their devices responsibly to support their studies, access educational resources, manage their time and develop the digital skills required for higher education and the workplace.

By using mobile phones appropriately, students will build the professional habits and self-discipline expected in the world of work, while ensuring their use does not disrupt learning or the wider Sixth Form and School environment.

Use of Mobile Phones

Mobile phone should only be used in:

- Sixth Form centre.
- form time or lessons when the teacher gives permission to the students to use them.

Mobile phones should not be out or used:

- walking around the school site.
- working in the library.
- in lessons or form time.

If a mobile phone is seen or heard at an inappropriate time, the following sanctions will apply:

- First time in a half term – phone confiscated for the remainder of the day, placed in the school office for collection by the student at the end of the day. A note will be added to Bromcom, so parents and students are aware.
- Second time in a half term – phone confiscated until Friday, placed in the school office for collection by the student at 3.00pm on Friday. A note will be added to Bromcom and an email informing the parent/carer will also be sent home. Parents or carers will be able to collect the phone from reception before Friday if they have concerns about their child not having their phone for travel.
- Third time in half term – phone confiscated until Friday, placed in the school office for collection by the student at 3.00pm on Friday. A meeting with the Year Team Leader will be requested and a note will also be added to Bromcom. Parents will be able to collect the phone from reception before Friday if they have concerns about their child not having their phone for travel.
