IN FOCUS - UNIFORM

At The Grange, uniform plays an important role in promoting a sense of pride, belonging and equality across our school community. Wearing the correct uniform helps students present themselves professionally and supports a positive learning environment.

Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform each day. If students are not in the correct uniform, they may be sent home to change or families asked to bring the correct uniform into school.

Currently, a significant number of students are wearing their skirts rolled up, resulting in them being shorter than intended. From next week, there will be a renewed focus on ensuring skirts are worn correctly. Students will be asked to unroll their skirts at the start of the school day and are expected to wear them appropriately throughout the day. If students do not wish to wear the skirt at its intended length, they may choose to wear black school trousers instead. 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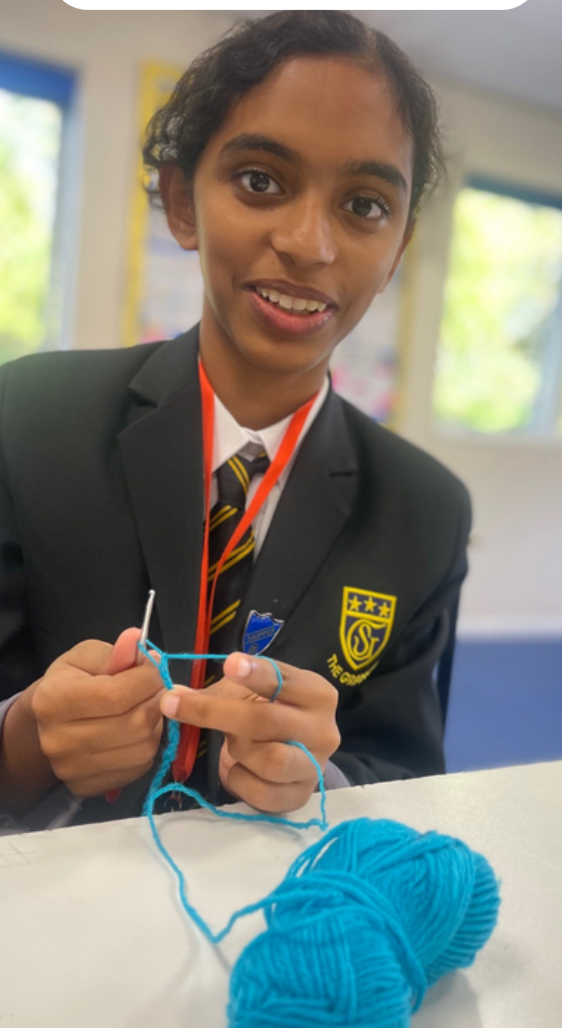

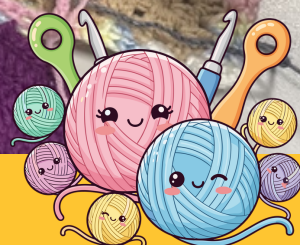
